Today's BIG IDEA:

The hands of God are always stronger and surer than our own.

1. We can trust God with our _____ (2:19-20)

- *If you follow the Lord day-by-day, he won't let you miss his will along the way.*

2. We can trust God with our _____ (2:21-23a)

(1 Samuel 24:1-22; 26:1-25; Romans 12:14-21)

- *Evildoers will be accountable to God for their **actions** toward us, but we will be accountable to God for our **reactions** toward them.*

3. We can trust God with our _____ (2:23b-3:1)

(Matthew 6:1-4; Proverbs 11:21; 2 Corinthians 5:10; Revelation 20:12)

- *We should never do a righteous deed for the sake of being noticed. We should do it because it is the right thing to do.*

2. What would you have done if you were in Mordecai's situation? Why is it so hard to show mercy to those who harm us?
