(Deuteronomy 8:2-17)

3. We should _____ God’s faithfulness (9:26b-28)
(Psalm 78:2-7)

- *What could be more important to pass along to your family than your love for the Lord and your stories of his faithfulness?*

4. We should _____ to God’s faithfulness (9:29-10:1)
(James 1:23-24)

- *Remembering the stories of the **past** doesn’t mean anything if it doesn’t affect how you live in the **present**.*
