### **Today's BIG IDEA:**

***In a tale of two paths, Jesus makes all the difference.***

#### **Option #1**

- an \_\_\_\_\_ end
- a \_\_\_\_\_ crowd
- an \_\_\_\_\_ way  
Tolerance is often the battle cry along the easy way
- a \_\_\_\_\_ gate  
We stand at this wide gate and the problem is we can't see the end from the entryway.

#### **Option #2**

- a \_\_\_\_\_ gate  
(John 10:9; Mark 8:29; Proverbs 1:23)
- a \_\_\_\_\_ way  
(John 14:6; Luke 14:26-27, 33)  
This way means saying no to self and offering your life as a living sacrifice - a blank check with a blank envelope...whatever the way costs, wherever the way takes you.
- a \_\_\_\_\_ crowd  
(Revelation 7:9)
- a \_\_\_\_\_ end  
(John 14:6)

### **APPLICATION QUESTIONS:**

1. Read and discuss Romans 10:14-15...Specifically, discuss these verses in light of today's message? Why does evangelism matter?
2. If you're a Christian, think of your life before salvation. What/Who did God use to help bring you to the path of Jesus? How can God use your story to help others?
