Today's BIG IDEA: Jesus has authority over our storms.	C. Jesus slept because he was <u>TEACHING</u> his disciples something
1. Jesus sometimes us into storms (v.23-24a) (1 Peter 4:12; Psalm 23:4)	3. Jesus alone can us from our storms (v.25-26a) (Acts 4:12)
