Today's BIG IDEA:

Following Jesus and rejecting Jesus each come with a price, but only one is worth it.

 - Ruled Galilee from 4 BC 39 AD

- Herod Antipas married the wife (Herodias) of his brother (Herod Philip)
- John called out Herod Antipas and Herodias for their sin and was imprisoned (v.3-5)
- Herod Antipas' step-daughter (Salome) danced at his birthday party, and he offered her whatever she wanted in return (v.6-7)

• Prompted by her mother (Herodias), Salome asked for John's head, and John was beheaded (v.8-12)
