**Today's BIG IDEA:**

***Regardless of your situation, Jesus offers healing and hope.***

1. Jesus highlights his \_\_\_\_\_

- *There is no situation so hopeless that Jesus can't heal it.*

\_\_\_\_\_ **of the unmarried** (v.10-12)  
*(1 Corinthians 7:8-9,32-34)*

- *It may be that God has called you to a life of singleness so that you can serve the Lord with a singular focus.*
