

## “The Dead Truth”

Matthew 27:55-66

### **Today's BIG IDEA:**

***We must be confident in the death of Jesus to be confident in the resurrection of Jesus.***

### 1. Three RESPONSES to Jesus' death

A. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the women (v.55-56)  
(Matthew 20:20-21; Luke 8:2)

- *The presence of the women at the tomb is a marked contrast to the absence of the disciples.*

B. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Joseph (v.57-61)  
(John 19:38)

- *Once a “secret” disciple, Joseph now boldly steps forward when no one else would.*

C. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Pharisees (v.62-66)

### 2. Three REALITIES regarding Jesus' death

A. Jesus' body was most assuredly \_\_\_\_\_  
(Luke 23:43,46; John 19:33-35; 1 Peter 3:18)

- *Jesus' body was dead, but his spirit was very much alive.*

B. Jesus' body was most assuredly \_\_\_\_\_  
(1 Corinthians 15:1-4)

- *If there wasn't a dead Jesus in that tomb, then there isn't a risen Jesus from the tomb.*

C. Jesus' body was most assuredly \_\_\_\_\_

- *In their efforts to protect against Jesus' body being stolen, the Pharisees unintentionally ensured the authenticity of the resurrection.*
