Today's BIG IDEA:

We must be confident in the death of Jesus to be confident in the resurrection of Jesus.

- The presence of the women at the tomb is a marked contrast to the absence of the disciples.
- B. The ______ of Joseph (v.57-61) (John 19:38)
 - Once a "secret" disciple, Joseph now boldly steps forward when no one else would.

C. The ______ of the Pharisees (v.62-66)

2. Three **REALITIES** regarding Jesus' death

A. Jesus' body was most assuredly	
(Luke 23:43,46; John 19:33-35; 1 Peter 3:18)	

- Jesus' body was dead, but his spirit was very much alive.
- - If there wasn't a dead Jesus in that tomb, then there isn't a risen Jesus from the tomb.
- C. Jesus' body was most assuredly _____
 - In their efforts to protect against Jesus' body being stolen, the Pharisees unintentionally ensured the authenticity of the resurrection.
