## "Responding to the Resurrection"

Matthew 28:9-17  Today's BIG IDEA: Instead of "moving on" from the resurrection, we should be moved by it.	

• To admit that Jesus was resurrected requires an admission that he is Lord.

**2. Some \_\_\_\_\_\_ the resurrection** (v. 16-17) (Mark 16:12-13; Luke 24:9,11,37; John 16:7,13; 20:24-25; Romans 8:11)

\_\_\_\_\_ for those who doubt A. There is \_ (Jude 22)

B. There is \_\_\_\_\_\_ for those who doubt (John 20:27-28)

• A touch from Jesus is all it takes to dispel our doubts.

• Christians don't just have Jesus **beside** us. We have Jesus inside us.

**3. Some \_\_\_\_\_ upon the resurrection** (v.9-10,16-17) (Philippians 3:8a, 10-11)

• They knew that Jesus was risen, and they knew that Jesus was Lord.

• If we truly believe that Jesus conquered death, how could we not worship him?
