## “Responding to the Resurrection”

Matthew 28:9-17

**Today's BIG IDEA:**

***Instead of “moving on” from the resurrection, we should be moved by it.***

**1. Some \_\_\_\_\_ the resurrection** (v.11-15)  
(1 Corinthians 15:12b,34)

- To admit that Jesus was resurrected requires an admission that he is Lord.

**2. Some \_\_\_\_\_ the resurrection** (v.16-17)  
(Mark 16:12-13; Luke 24:9,11,37; John 16:7,13; 20:24-25; Romans 8:11)

A. There is \_\_\_\_\_ for those who doubt  
(Jude 22)

B. There is \_\_\_\_\_ for those who doubt  
(John 20:27-28)

- A touch from Jesus is all it takes to dispel our doubts.
- Christians don't just have Jesus **beside** us. We have Jesus **inside** us.

**3. Some \_\_\_\_\_ upon the resurrection** (v.9-10,16-17)  
(Philippians 3:8a,10-11)

- They knew that Jesus was risen, and they knew that Jesus was Lord.
- If we truly believe that Jesus conquered death, how could we not worship him?
