## "Raising Kingdom Kids"

Proverbs 22:1-6

If we're going to build Christ's kingdom, we must point the next generation to the King.

- **1. A parental** \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 1-6a)
  - "Train" = Hebrew **chanak**, of which one meaning is "to stimulate a child's appetite for something"
  - A. Train them in \_\_\_\_\_ (v.1) (Proverbs 19:1)

- B. Train them in \_\_\_\_\_ (v.2) (Psalm 100:3)
  - Our worth is not in what we have. It is in whose we are.

C. Train them in \_\_\_\_\_ (v.3,5) (2 Timothy 2:22)

- D. Train them in \_\_\_\_\_ (v.4) (Psalm 78:3,4)
  - You can train your children to be smart, successful, and connected. But that won't do them any good if they go to hell.
  - You can't mandate what you don't model.
- **2. A parental** \_\_\_\_\_ (v.6b) (Colossians 4:2; Isaiah 55:11)
  - Even if your child takes a detour from the truth, the truth will never depart from them.
