## **“Raising Kingdom Kids”**

Proverbs 22:1-6

### **Today’s BIG IDEA:**

***If we’re going to build Christ’s kingdom, we must point the next generation to the King.***

### **1. A parental \_\_\_\_\_ (v.1-6a)**

- “Train” = Hebrew **chanak**, of which one meaning is “to stimulate a child’s appetite for something”

A. Train them in \_\_\_\_\_ (v.1)  
(Proverbs 19:1)

B. Train them in \_\_\_\_\_ (v.2)  
(Psalm 100:3)

- Our worth is not in what we have. It is in whose we are.

C. Train them in \_\_\_\_\_ (v.3,5)  
(2 Timothy 2:22)

D. Train them in \_\_\_\_\_ (v.4)  
(Psalm 78:3,4)

- You can train your children to be smart, successful, and connected. But that won’t do them any good if they go to hell.

- You can’t mandate what you don’t model.

### **2. A parental \_\_\_\_\_ (v.6b)** (Colossians 4:2; Isaiah 55:11)

- Even if your child takes a detour from the truth, the truth will never depart from them.

### 3. A churchwide \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 1-6)
