#### CONNECT GROUPS

Each member of your family has an age-appropriate class every Sunday morning from 9:15-10:15 that we call "Connect Groups." Babies through Kindergarten meet in our Preschool wing, while 1st-5th grade meet upstairs. Our students meet



in the GAP downstairs as a large group and then Split into grade-level classes. Our College/Young Adult class is upstairs on the north end for those just graduating, beginning college, or getting settled in their new career.
