## CONNECT GROUPS

Each member of your family has an age-appropriate class every Sunday morning from 9:15-10:15 that we call "Connect Groups." Babies through Kindergarten meet in our Preschool wing, while 1st-5th grade meet upstairs. Our students meet in the GAP downstairs as a large group and then Split into grade-level classes. Our College/Young Adult class is upstairs on the north end for those just graduating, beginning college, or getting settled in their new career.

## WEEKDAYS DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR

On Tuesdays, there are two options for our 18-25 young adults - see our events for details. Our First Kidz ministry (including Preschool) meets from 6:00-7:30pm on Wednesdays, while our students meet in the GAP at the same time. We also have a bible study on Fridays at 7:00am in the GAP for 6th-12th grade girls.
