## **“Knowing God’s Grace”**

Psalm 86:1-17

### **Today’s BIG IDEA:**

***When we desperately need grace, God richly supplies it.***

**1. God is \_\_\_\_\_ in his grace** (v.8-10)

- *The better we understand God's glory, the greater we'll appreciate God's grace.*
- *Grace is a holy God's unmerited favor toward humanity.*
