Today's BIG IDEA:

Obedience to the Lord will always lead to opposition from the world.

1. Gospel opposition often follows gospel

(v.1-2) (Matthew 10:16-18a; 1 Peter 4:12)

• If we find ourselves in step with the world, it probably means that we're out of step with Jesus.

2. Gospel opposition doesn't stop gospel

(Isaiah 55:11; 1 Corinthians 15:58)

• The world may seek to silence gospel messengers, but it can never stop the gospel message.

(v.3-4)

3. Gospel opposition provides gospel

(Matthew 10:18)

• The more gospel opposition we face, the more gospel opportunities we'll have.

__ (v.5-12)

4. Gospel opposition can't deny gospel

_____ (v.13-16,22)

• If we want people to see the power of the gospel, then we must walk with the one who holds that power.

5. Gospel opposition calls us to deeper gospel

_____ (v.17-21)

• The commandments of God always supersede the commandments of men.

- 3. In what ways might you be forced to make a decision between obeying God and obeying men? How will you respond?
