Today’s BIG IDEA:

When churches face difficult decisions, the gospel provides the answer.

1. Remember the context and _____ (v.1-5)

- Decisions made in haste and haughtiness will be more harmful than helpful.

2. Remember the basics of _____ (v.6-11)

(Galatians 1:9; Ephesians 2:8-9)

- Salvation comes by **grace alone** through **faith alone** in **Christ alone**.

3. Remember the teaching of _____ (v.12-21)

(Amos 9:11-12; 2 Timothy 3:16)

- What we think about spiritual questions doesn't matter nearly as much as what God has already said about them.

4. Remember the goal of _____ (v.22-35)

(1 Corinthians 10:24)

- The goal of Christian debate should be to promote corporate righteousness, not personal rightness.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS:

1. When have you seen selfishness and dissension harm a church? How can we prevent that from happening in our church?
2. If Scripture is going to guide our decisions, how can you more effectively internalize and apply God's Word?
3. Are you more concerned about advancing your agenda or advancing the gospel? What areas of selfishness and pride do you need to repent of?
