4. God sent Paul to a _____ neighbor (v.7-11)

- *Sometimes God allows us to experience “failure” so that he can move us into a place of fruitfulness.*

5. God sent Paul to a _____ official (v.12-17)

(Daniel 2:21a)

- *God doesn’t just put Christians where he wants us; he sets up divine appointments for nonbelievers, too.*
