Today’s BIG IDEA:

The finish of our Christian journey is just as important as the start.

1. An incomplete _____ resumed (v.1a)
(Proverbs 25:14; Acts 18:19-21)

- As much as it is up to us, we should keep our commitments.

2. An incomplete _____ explained (v.1b-4)
(John 3:3; Acts 18:25; Romans 8:9-16; 10:9)

- Could it be that there are “disciples” walking around today that aren’t true disciples of Jesus?

3. An incomplete _____ completed (v.5-7)
(Acts 2:4; 8:17; Ephesians 1:13-14)

- True salvation isn’t intellectual. It’s incarnational.

4. An incomplete _____ fulfilled (v.8-10)
(1 Corinthians 9:22b)

- Fruitful ministry may not always be conventional ministry.
