Today’s BIG IDEA:

An impersonal faith is an illegitimate faith.

1. Genuine faith is _____ (v.11-12)
(Ephesians 3:20-21)

- God delights in doing extraordinary things in and through ordinary people who walk with him.

2. Genuine faith is _____ (v.13-14)
(1 Corinthians 8:4-6)

- Many people are more interested in **using** Jesus than **knowing** Jesus.

3. Genuine faith is _____ (v.15-17a)
(Matthew 7:21-23; James 2:19)

- Don't let the demons know Jesus better than you.
- You may not have to go toe to toe with a demon, but you will have to stand face to face with God.

4. Genuine faith can be _____ (v.17b-20)
(Matthew 16:24-26)

- If genuine faith was available to the Ephesians, it's available to us.
- To experience genuine faith, we must exhibit genuine repentance—and that always comes with a cost.

2. Is there anything in your life that you need to “burn” (v.19)? What might God be calling you to rid your life of so that you can completely pursue him?



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
